Study Program for Environmental Educators

- SYKLI has developed a Study Program for Environmental Educators. The program was launched in 2013 and is the highest vocational qualification in the Finnish education system.
- The aim is to increase the quality of environmental education in all levels of the Finnish education system, and thus to enhance skills in implementing the national sustainability requirements.





Environmental education

- Environmental educator = a person, who promotes sustainable change in their organisation (not necessarily a "traditional" pedagogical profession)
- We aim at societies that live within the planetary boudaries
- Training is aimed at diverse professional groups





New openings for environmental education training


- 2022- The field of culture, museums and other non formal learning environments such as libraries

- The themes of the trainings are sustainability, creativity, playfulness, activites in nature, safety as well as participatory approaches and equity.
- Testing new methods to use arts and advenure education together with skills to enhance nature literacy.

- Participants gain concrete tools to work together with nature in their organisations. These are both skills to enhance the wellbeing at the workplace as well as pedagogical skills for vocational teachers.
