Some practicalities

Helsinki, how to get there?

There are good ferry connections to Helsinki from Stockholm and from Tallinn but possibly you are arriving by plane to Helsinki-Vantaa airport. Also, airports of Tampere and Turku could be considered, if you to travel a bit more and see other cities.

Commuter trains I and P operate from Helsinki -Vantaa Airport daily every 10 minutes to Helsinki city center (daytime). I train operate via Tikkurila and P train via Huopalahti. But both goes through Pasila railway station which is very close to Sykli's office.

Night bus 415 (N) operates to and from Helsinki Airport. Many long-distance buses also stop at the airport.



Travelling in Helsinki, local traffic

To get to or from the airport, you will need an ABC ticket, which you can purchase from HSL ticket machines, through HSL mobile app or sales points like R-kiosk. We recommend warmly to download HSL Application and buy for example 7 days ticket there (44 euros / ABC).

Helsinki has an excellent public transport system (HSL) comprising bus, tram, metro, commuter train and ferry services. Also with a single ticket you can hop aboard trams, buses, the metro and even the municipal ferry to Suomenlinna as long as your ticket is still valid.

Easiest routes to Sykli's office

Suomen ympäristöopisto SYKLI Esterinportti 1, 3. krs.

Tram and bus stops are right in front of Tripla shopping Mall very near of Sykli. All commuter and long-distance trains also stop in Pasila. Our office is within 5-minute walk (about 400 meters) from Pasila railway station.

Finding accommodation

Naturally a lot of hotels can be found nearby of Sykli's office, but if you take your accommodation nearby of any railway stop, travelling to Sykli is fast even from longer distances. Google Maps and HSL app route planning are good tools to use at the same when you consider your accommodation.

Also affordable options can be found. Using applications like Hotels.com it is possible to find rooms starting from 50 euros per night. Take account that neighbouring cities Espoo and Vantaa can be considered as well, especially when a place near a railway stop can be found.
